

Taunton Vale Foxhounds Pre- Hunting course

PLEASE NOTE: Whilst we will make every effort to avoid this, we may have to alter or cancel parts of the programme on account of prevailing government Covid-19 regulations (please see registration form)

We aim to make this an enjoyable and informative day for all participants regardless of previous experience. The course is designed equally for:

- Newcomers or less experienced hunters who wish to improve their knowledge and horsemanship skills on the hunting field;
- Experienced hunters who wish to brush up on their riding skills, practise jumping natural obstacles and hopefully learn something new.

Outline of the day

- Social distancing and other prevailing C-19 regulations must be adhered to throughout. Any further details will be published when you are notified of your section and ride
- The day will run from 0900 and should finish by 1630. Lunch is included in the cost of the day. Please indicate choice of menu on the Registration Form. All timings are approximate.
- You will bring your own horse and appropriate riding clothes, including crash hat and body protector to current British Standards. Please also bring a face mask, gloves, and drinking mug
- Please note that no accompanying non-riders will be permitted owing to C19 regulations and capacity of the venues
- Riders will be divided into two separate sections, each of four rides, for the morning.
- You will receive 1 ½ hrs mounted tuition with an emphasis on learning how to cope with various obstacles and incidents that could occur during a day's hunting.
- Before or after your mounted tuition there will be a talk "Everything you wanted to know about......hunting, but were afraid to ask". This will be given by Polly Portwin, The Countryside Alliance's Head of Hunting, covering tips on preparation for and participation in a day's hunting. Please note – this will take place outside the Café and whilst the gazebos placed there will provide some protection please bring warm clothing. If the weather is bad, we may have to cancel this part of the day.

- In the afternoon, there will be two cross country rides, each led by a Field Master. These will take in a variety of obstacles but there will always be a way round, just as when hunting.
- There will be a voluntary collection for the Dorset & Somerset Air Ambulance during the day.
- Cost £85, Paid up subscribers of the Taunton Vale Foxhounds £70.
- Overnight stabling and accommodation available. Please apply to Pontispool for reservations and charges.

 - b. 1100 1230 mounted training in rides of up to 5
- 3. 1300 -1400 Lunch
- 4. 1430- 1600 approx Cross country ride round Pontispool in two separate groups: smaller and larger fences
- 5. 1630 Finish
