**Class 1** Mini 70-75cm Team & Individual Qualifier (Riders to be aged under 14 on 1<sup>st</sup> January 2019) Single phase. All team riders automatically count as individuals.

**Class 2** Novice 80-85cm Team & Individual Qualifier Single phase. All team riders automatically count as individuals.

**Class 3** Intermediate 90-95cm Team & Individual Qualifier. Single phase. All team riders automatically count as individuals

**Class 4** 1m-1.05 Open Team & Individual Qualifier Single phase. All team riders automatically count as individuals

**Class 5a/b** 1.10m Advanced Open Individual Qualifier Single phase. This class will be split into 5a) Horses, 5b) Ponies

### Entry Fee: £16.50 per rider per round

Paramedic First Aid Cover included in entry fee.

No entries will be accepted on day of competition. Any alterations to entries will incur a £3 admin fee.

In the event of cancellation due to weather, a full refund less £5 admin fee will be issued on receipt of a sae.
