Winter Eventers Challenge 2018-19

The course is made up of SJ & XC fences.

Riders will jump a series of show jumps and then proceed immediately into the XC phase. NSEA / BE Eventing Rules for tack & rider equipment.

There will be no style mark.

Points will be awarded to teams of 3 or 4, best 3 scores to count. 6 points to 1st down to 1 point to 6th place.

The course will be run in the all-weather arena and will be made up of approx.

16-18 fences

Class 1 Novice 80-85cm Team & Individual (Hickstead qualifier) Single phase. All team riders automatically count as individuals.

Optimum Time (Combined SJ & XC) Speed 325 mpm.

Class 2 Intermediate 90-95cm Team & Individual (Hickstead qualifier)

Single phase. All team riders automatically count as individuals.

Optimum Time (Combined SJ & XC) Speed 325 mpm.

Class 3 1m-1.05 Open Team & Individual (Hickstead qualifier)

Single phase. All team riders automatically count as individuals.

Optimum Time (Combined SJ & XC) Speed 350 mpm.

Teams of 3 or 4, best 3 scores to count

Entry Fee for classes 1 - 3 = £35 per rider per round

Paramedic First Aid Cover and VAT included in entry fee.

Entries close 12 noon 29th October, or earlier if classes are full.

No entries will be accepted on day of competition.

Any alterations to entries will incur a £6 admin fee.

Withdrawals made prior to closing date will receive a refund of the entry with a £6 admin fee deducted.

No refunds will be given after close of entries.

In the event of cancellation, 50% of your entry fee will be refunded on receipt of a sae.

START TIMES will be published on the website www.pontispool.com from 3 pm on Thursday 1st November or telephone the office on 01823 461196 between 10 am and 12 noon on Friday 2nd November. Times will also be available on the NSEA website before the competition www.nsea.org.uk

Body protectors are compulsory. Hair must be above collar length, long hair to be kept in place in a hair net. Crash hats, no fixed peak SJ hats.

In the event of a tie, the competitor with the fewest jumping penalties and closest to the optimum time will be the winner. If teams are tied, the times of the 3 best scores closest to the optimum time will be the winner.

Jumping penalties are awarded as follows....

Knockdown (to include SJ and a few xc fences)	4 penalties
1st Refusal	4 penalties
2nd Refusal	8 penalties
3rd Refusal	Elimination
1st Rider Fall	Elimination
Horse Fall	Compulsory Retirement
Starting before the bell /Retaking an obstacle already jumped/ Error of course	Elimination
Every commenced second over or under the optimum time	1 penalty
Exceeding time limit (3 times the time allowed)	Elimination
Speed 325 metres / minute for Class 1 and 350 meters / minute for Classes 2 & 3	
No stopwatches allowed.
