

### **British Showjumping Club Classes:**

Please note you don't have to be a British Showjumping Club member to jump in any of these classes. **Unaffiliated riders can enter these classes and win rosettes too.** The only difference being, 'Club' members having a result will collect more points towards their own Regional league rankings. Join the British Showjumping 'Club' within seven days of being placed at Pontispool and you will have the opportunity of competing in Regional League finals too.

For any horse/rider, pony/rider combination without a registered result in British Showjumping National Amateur 85cm, British Novice, Pony British Novice, Stepping Stones and above in the last 3 years. Adults are eligible to ride ponies and children can ride horses from the beginning of the calendar year in which the age of 12 is reached (FEI rules).

League points awarded as follows: 1<sup>st</sup> – 12 points, 2<sup>nd</sup> – 10 points, 3<sup>rd</sup> – 8 points, 4<sup>th</sup> – 6 points, 5<sup>th</sup> – 4 points, 6<sup>th</sup> – 3 points. Three points will be allocated to all those who achieve double clears, those who are placed will receive an additional 3 points if they have jumped a double clear. All results to be graded – full competition record. Competitors can register as a Club Member up to 7 days from the date of competing and regain points won. See British Showjumping website for more details and how to join. **Ponies and horses are placed seperately please state clearly on entry if a PONY or HORSE.**

### **Cricklands Qualifiers:**

A double clear in any class (not clear round) qualifies horse and rider combination for the Jumping Championships to be held at the David Broome Event Centre, Monmouthshire. A registration card must be completed and signed by the secretary on the day. Seniors: 12<sup>th</sup> – 14<sup>th</sup> August 2016 and Juniors: 27<sup>th</sup> – 29<sup>th</sup> August 2016.

### **General Conditions:**

1. No responsibility can be taken by the organisers for any accident or damage to competitors, attendants, animals, spectators or their property, or vehicles of any description. By entering this competition, the exhibitor of any horse or pony accepts that Pontispool Equine Sports Centre, the organiser or any of the officers of the show will not be held responsible or accountable for anything that may happen from any cause or circumstance whatsoever to any persons, exhibitors or their servants or to any animal or article or property brought into the showground.
2. In all matters the Judges' decision is final.
3. Hats to current British Safety Standard must be worn when mounted. Back Protectors are advised. BSJA dress code.
4. All competitors take part at their own risk and are expected to exercise due care at all times and obey all notices placed for their control.
5. Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times.
6. Practice jumps must be approached from the direction indicated.
7. Objections must be made in writing to the Secretary's Office with a £10 deposit and within 15 minutes of the incident. The deposit will be refunded if the objection is sustained.
8. The organiser reserves the right to alter the schedule, refuse any entry and to cancel any class.
9. In the event of cancellation a full refund will be made less a £1 admin fee.

### **Rules:**

- Knock down 4 faults
- First refusal 4 faults
- Second refusal (anywhere on the course) 4 faults
- Third refusal (anywhere on the course) Elimination
- Fall of horse/rider (anywhere on the course) Elimination
- All other faults as per British Showjumping rule book
- Hors Concours entries will be taken at the discretion of the secretary
- If a horse jumps twice in one class the second round and all future classes entered will be Hors Concours.
