## **RULES**

- 1. Horses can be entered only once.
- 2. All ages will be as of 01.01.19
- 3. There will be no time section.
- 4. No entries accepted without the correct fee.
- 5 The Judge or Committee's decision is final in all matters.
- 6 Whilst every effort has been made to ensure the safety of horses, riders and persons present the Silverton Hunt cannot be held responsible for any accident however caused.
- 7 Hats, Skull Caps for XC, Body Protectors and Medical Armbands **must** be worn, where necessary & conform to current PC standards. All compete at their own risk. Hats and body protectors will be checked when collecting numbers
- 8 All dogs to be kept on leads at all times.
- 9 We reserve the right to a) cancel any class b) refuse entry c) divide any class d) transfer competitors between sections of a class e) alter advertised times
- 10. Classes may not run in order.
- 11. It is forbidden for competitors to wear stop watches
- 12. Horses and Ponies should have a valid passport and failure to produce one for inspection will be the owner's responsibility.
- 13. No refunds after the closing date. 50% refund before the closing date. In case of abandonment ring Pontispool 01823 461196. If the competition has to be abandoned by the organisers 50% of the entry fee will be retained for expenses.
- 14. Competitors should report to the steward for each phase at least 10 minutes before their allotted start time.
- 15. Any outside assistance will result in disqualification
- 16. Class 1 only competitors may continue to the next fence on the cross country course after 3 refusals with permission from the jump judge, provided priority is given to other competitors on the course

- 17. Should a rider fall during the Show jumping phase, the judge must be satisfied the rider is capable of continuing. After 2 falls, the competitor will be eliminated. For any eliminated competitor wishing to continue to the cross country phase of the competition, permission must be obtained from the show jumping judge immediately after elimination.
- 18. All competitors MUST wear a body protector for the cross country phase and it is recommended one also be worn for show jumping. If wearing the new locking form of body protector, please a) ensure a key is carried on the person at all times b) advise the secretary on arrival and provide a spare key for the paramedics to hold in case of accident
- 19. No fences, other than those marked for the purpose, may be used for practice. No galloping or cantering outside the warm up areas.
- 20. If any person lodges an objection, such objection must be made within 30 minutes of the incident together with a deposit of £15 to be returned if the objection is upheld.
- 21. Participants in this competition (who are not paid up members of a Pony Club/ Riding Club) must hold their own Accident and Public Liability Insurance
