## **Directions:**

Pontispool is very easy to find if you follow these directions. DO NOT use SAT NAV

#### From the North and East – Directions from J25 (M5)

Head towards Taunton and follow A358 signed for Minehead and the Norton Fitzwarren and then Wiveliscombe (B3227). At Cross Keys Pub roundabout (approx. 2 miles from M5) take the first exit onto B3227. Drive through Norton Fitzwarren and over the railway bridge. Then follow the brown horseshoe tourist signs to Pontispool.

#### From the South and West – Directions from J26 (M5)

On leaving the motorway head towards Wellington and take the 4<sup>th</sup> exit the first roundabout onto A38 to Taunton. At the next roundabout (approx. 5 miles - National Tyres to the right) takes the first exit. At the next roundabout take the first exit. At Cross Keys Pub roundabout (approx. 2 miles from M5) take the first exit onto B3227. Drive through Norton Fitzwarren and over the railway bridge. Then follow the brown horseshoe tourist signs to Pontispool.

#### All classes are open to Non Members as well as Members of TSW and of TREC GB Non Members pay TREC GB rates PLUS £5 day membership of TSW. Current standard body protectors required in ALL ridden classes.

## 1. NEWCOMER

Open to RIDERS that have not been placed 1st in two or more NEWCOMER classes, or to have won an Intermediate or an Open class at WINTER TREC Competitions prior to 1st October 2017. PTV obstacles equivalent to Level 1.

## Entry Fee TSW £15 – TREC GB £18

This class may run in a different part of the arena if there are a lot of entries.

## 2. NOVICE HORSE

Open to HORSES that have not been placed 1st in two or more NEWCOMER classes, or to have won an Intermediate or an Open class at WINTER TREC Competitions prior to 1st October 2017 PTV obstacles equivalent to Level 1. Entry Fee TSW £15 – TREC GB £18

## 3. CASH POT LUCKY DIP PAIRS

Open to any horse and rider combinations. Rider must have competed in a TSW pairs class at some point during this season. Each horse will complete 10 obstacles and EITHER the Canter or the Walk part of the MA. Simple enter the class (as an individual) and we will match you with a partner from a draw. Entry Fee Each Rider TSW £12 – TREC GB £15

## 4. CASH POT HANDICAP

Open to all horses and riders – combinations will be given a handicap score (average of THIS year's scores) that will be added to the score they achieve on the day. If horse and rider have not competed this year their handicap the same as the lowest handicap score of the day.

## Entry fee TSW £15 – TREC GB £18

## 5. INTERMEDIATE

Horse and rider combination not to have been placed 1st in two or more INTERMEDIATE classes, or to have won an Open class at WINTER TREC competitions prior to 1st October 2017. PTV obstacles equivalent to Level 2/3

## Entry Fee TSW £15 – TREC GB £18

## 6. OPEN

Open to all horses and riders PTV obstacles equivalent to Level 3/4.

## 7. EXTREME TREC

If you are looking for a challenge this class is for you! Open to all – not suitable for novice horse and rider combinations. Entry Fee TSW £15 – TREC GB £18.

### 8. SCHOOLING ROUNDS

On a different course – TSW £10 TREC GB £15 - for 10 minutes – please leave obstacles as you found them. Instruction may be available – please ask on your entry form.

## 9. In Hand Class (open to all)

On a different course – TSW £10 TREC GB £12 – full course of PTV obstacles

**SIGNED:** If the competitor is under 16 a parent or guardian must sign. A parental consent form must also be sent for any riders under 16.

## **GENERAL RULES & CONDITIONS**

Placing will be decided with the rider gaining the highest combined score from the PTV and Control of Paces phases taking the first prize. In the event of equality the highest score from PTV will take precedence.

RULES AS PER THE TREC GB RULEBOOK AVAILABLE TO DOWNLOAD FROM WWW.TRECGB.COM

- Competitions are open to all horses and ponies providing that they are a minimum of 4yrs of age Ridden and 2 for In Hand classes.
- > Riders any age, juniors may ride horses and seniors may ride ponies.
- No rider will be permitted to start any phase of the event unless wearing a hard hat, which meets current standard recommended by the BHS (PAS 015, VG1 or ASTMF 1163 and bearing kite mark or SEI) that is properly fitted and fastened with a chinstrap.
- PLEASE NOTE THAT HATS THAT ARE STANDARD EN 1384 ONLY CAN NO LONGER BE USED IN A TREC COMPETITION. Hats as stated above are acceptable.
- Riders MUST wear a Beta level 3 (purple label) body protector 2000 or 2009
- > Tack & dress informal but safe. Riders must wear suitable riding footwear.
- Standing Martingales and other fixed reins are forbidden. If a running martingale is used, horse must be led from headcollar and leadrope for led PTV obstacles.
- Whips must not exceed 75cms. Spurs, if worn, must be rounded, not exceeding 3.5cms in length and pointed downwards.
- The judges and officials decision is final and must be complied with at all times. Uncorrected error on PTV course will result in a ZERO score for the PTV.
- Elimination may result for any of the following reasons: Excessive use of whip, Abusive language, Dangerous riding.
- > No horse or pony may compete more than once in any affiliated class.
