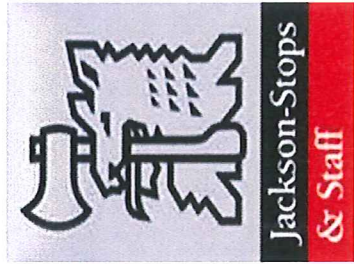




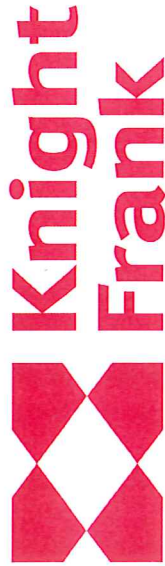

Rules

- Riding Hats must comply with the Pony Club rules 2016, which can be found at <http://www.pcupk.org>
Failure to comply with these rules will result in elimination.
- Back protectors must be worn for Cross Country.
- Medical armbands must be worn by all competitors on the Cross Country Course. These will be available from the secretary on the day of the event @ £3.50
- Spurs may only be worn by PC members on production of written permission from their DC
- Numbers - it is the responsibility of competitors to provide their own number bibs (some for sale on the day) for paper numbers.
- There will be a (fastest) timed section.
- Pairs classes will include 'dressing fences'.
- After 3 refusals riders may only proceed to the next fence with permission from the fence judge as long as they do not hinder or obstruct any following competitors.
Eliminated riders must miss out the timed section.
- No horse may compete more than twice.
- Age as on the day of the event.
- All entries will be taken in the order in which they are received.
- Entry fee refunded if withdrawal notified before closing date.
- Entries on the day only if space permits.
- The organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry.
- The judges' decision is final.
- All dogs must be kept on leads at all time.
