PRIZES: Prize Giving will be dismounted, Covid restrictions permitting. Trophies to winning teams and individuals. Rosettes to 8th place for individual and 4th place for teams, with best dressage rosettes in each section. Two London International Horse Show tickets for each winning team member and 1st Individual in each Class a)

STARTING TIMES: Times & numbers will be available from 12pm on Thursday 22nd September on www.eventingscores.co.uk

FOOD: Food and drink will be available to purchase throughout the event at Pontispool.

NUMBERS: Competitors must print their own numbers and provide their own number bibs.

CROSS-COUNTRY: Cross-Country course will be available to walk from 2pm Saturday 24th September 2022.

This event is run under Pony Club Eventing Rule Book 2022, save these additional rules:

- For each Class, a) riders must be 18 or under on the date of the event and b) is open to all.
- School numnahs will be permitted but not personalised.
- Dressage 70 cm any normal riding bit is permitted.
- A signed PC Membership card for use of spurs will <u>not</u> be required.
- All hats must be tagged; current PC aqua/BE or BRC tag must be visible.
- Any fall of horse or rider at any time will lead to immediate elimination from the competition.
- Space permitting, riders may ride more than one horse but not in the same team. Please email first choice details with team declarations.
- The XC course will be timed for all Classes. Stopwatches are permitted in Class 3.
- Appropriate Covid-19 guidelines and protocols will be in place at the time of the event. Further guidance will be issued before the event.

RESERVATION OF RIGHT:

- a) No refunds will be given after close of entries unless supported by Vet or Doctors note.
- b) In the event of cancellation, 50% of your entry fee will be refunded.
- c) If you would like to edit your horse or rider details before the closing date of the event, please login to your Horse Events account and edit your booking under the 'MY BOOKING' Tab.
- d) If you would like to change the Class, please email info@horse-events.co.uk and if there is space available, we will do this for you.

Directions to Pontispool Equine Sports Centre

Do NOT use Sat Nav - this can be misleading and take you around the narrow lanes, please use the directions below to access us via the B3227.

From The North and East - Directions from Junction 25 (M5) Head towards Taunton and follow the A358 signed for Minehead then Norton Fitzwarren and Wiveliscombe (B3227). At The Cross Keys Pub round-about (approx 2 miles from the M5), take the first exit onto the B3227. Drive through Norton Fitzwarren and over the railway bridge. Then follow the brown horseshoe tourist signs to Pontispool

From The South - Directions from Junction 26 (M5) On leaving the motorway, head towards Wellington and take the 4th exit at the first round-about onto the A38 to Taunton. At the next round-about (approx 5 miles - National Tyres to the right) take the first exit. At the next round-about take the first exit. At The Cross Keys Pub round-about (approx 2 miles from the M5), take the first exit onto the B3227. Drive through Norton Fitzwarren and over the railway bridge. Then follow the brown horseshoe tourist signs to Pontispool.
