- ACCOMMODATION LODGES AND CABINS -
New accommodation lodges are available - Pontispool is offering lodges at £70.00 per twin room per night. They can accommodate maximum of 16 people. Two single beds in each room with four rooms and 2 showers/loos in each and there are 2 lodges (Blackdown Lodge and Quantock Lodge)
Occupants will need to bring their own bedding.
Rooms will be allocated for 2 people - they will not be let for single use.

- DOGS - To be kept on leads at all times.
- RIDING
- Cross Country 100 ride - there will be adequate L Fences.
- A valid passport and vaccination record must accompany the horse/pony to this event and must be available for inspection if required by event officials. Vaccinations must be in accordance with the Pony Club Vaccination Rule 2022.
- No horse or pony may compete on the same day as a relevant injection is given or on any of the 6 days following such an injection.
- It is responsibility of the member or his/her parent to ensure all tack and equipment is safe and complies with the Pony Club rule books.
