Unaffiliated Eventing Championships
1st & 2nd October 2022
at Calmsden, Glos

The 80 and 90 classes are qualifiers for the Horse Events Unaffiliated Eventing Championships on 1st & 2nd October 2022 at Calmsden, Glos incorporating • Amateur ONLY classes • Open class for young horses • Schools Equestrian Games. To qualify you need to be placed in the top 7 of **eligible starters** at any 80, 90 or 100 unaffiliated event hosting a Horse Events Qualifier (HEQ)

These classes are qualifiers for Saracen Connemara Eventing Championships to be held on 10th/11th September 2022 at Swalcliffe Park, Oxfordshire OX15 5EX ([Swalcliffe Park Equestrian](#))

To qualify you must be placed in the top 10 of your section or have a double clear. Please ensure that you mark on your entry that you are riding a Connemara/Partbred if you want to be eligible.

DIRECTIONS TO PONTISPOOL: From junction 25 or 26 of the M5, follow the signs for Taunton, Wiveliscombe & Norton Fitzwarren. Pass through Norton Fitzwarren on the B3227 & follow the brown horseshoe tourist signs to Pontispool.

DRESSAGE TESTS: The Dressage takes place on grass & tests are available to download from: http://www.pcuk.org/index.php/sports/dressage/dressage_tests/ For PC70 and Open 70 classes the dressage test may be commanded.

SHOW JUMPING: Show Jumping will take place on the all-weather arena and is not timed

CROSS COUNTRY; The xc course will be ready to walk from 2pm on Friday.

70 and 80 classes – xc optimum time is based on 435mpm but no penalties incurred for going too slowly although penalties will be awarded for going too fast. At all levels completing the course in more than 15 seconds under the Optimum Time incurs 0.4 penalties for every second commenced. No stopwatches allowed.

90 classes – xc optimum time is based on 450 mpm with 0.4 penalty points incurred for every commenced second over the optimum time. Penalties will also be awarded for going too fast. Completing the course in more than 15 seconds under the Optimum Time incurs 0.4 penalties for every second commenced. Stopwatches are allowed for 90 classes.

STABLING: Stables available for hire @ £16 per day or £30 per night (including straw bed). These can be booked online at www.pontispool.com or by phoning the office 01823 461196.

COMPETITOR NUMBERS

Please provide your own number bib & print or write your number on THREE A4 sized pieces of paper for the front & back of your number bib and one for the windscreen of your vehicle. Bib numbers can be printed from www.ponyclubresults.co.uk when your times are made available.

Rules of Competition

The competition will be run in accordance with Pony Club eventing rules 2022 which can be viewed at <https://pcuk.org/officials/rulebooks/> & in accordance with current Government COVID-19 guidelines. Entry deems acceptance of this & any changes that have to be made.

1. All competitors compete at their own risk.
2. Horses may be entered only once & a maximum of 3 horses per rider
3. No horse may compete at both the SOVRC event on Saturday 4th June & the Silverton Pony Club event on Sunday 5th June
4. **All horses & ponies** on site must have a valid Passport & in date Flu vaccination certificate available for inspection with the most recent booster within the last twelve months, including any companions. Failure to produce this will result in all horses & ponies in the vehicle being asked to leave.
5. All fence heights are approximate.
6. If you are disqualified in the dressage or SJ you will not be allowed to go cross country unless the express permission of the chief steward is granted.
7. No entries accepted without the correct fee.
8. Late Entries will only be taken if there is space.
9. The Judge or Committee's decision is final in all matters.
10. Whilst every effort has been made to ensure the safety of horses, riders & persons present the SHPC cannot be held responsible for any accident however caused.
11. **No jewellery or piercings are allowed for safety reasons**, other than medical jewellery, a wristwatch, a wedding ring, a stock pin worn horizontally or a tie clip
12. Hats & Body Protectors **must** conform to current PC standards & hats must have the current aquamarine tag in place. Medical Armbands are recommended & body protectors are compulsory for xc. Hats tags will be checked at each phase.
13. All dogs to be kept on leads at all times.
14. The organiser reserves the right to alter the schedule, refuse any entry, eliminate any competitor not adhering to the rules, alter the course before or during the competition, alter the advertised times, cancel any class or section, divide any class & transfer competitors between sections.

15. Classes may not run in schedule order.
16. Horses & Ponies must be at least 5 years old.
17. Practice jumps must be approached from the direction indicated (red flag on right).
18. **Whips – the rules for whips have changed for 2022** For SJ & XC ‘A whip, if carried, must be “padded”. The maximum length of the “Whip” is 70cm & must be no less than 45cm.
19. Pony Club members are no longer required to produce a spur certificate.
20. Stop watches are allowed to be worn at PC90 but not at PC80 or below.
21. Objections must be made in writing to the Organiser with a £10 deposit & within 15 minutes of the incident. The deposit will be refunded if the objection is sustained.

23. Withdrawals on the day to be made by telephone or text to 07711 623381
24. **75% refund before the closing date. No refunds after the closing date unless we can replace your entry from the waitlist in which case 75% of the entry fee will be refunded.**
25. Changing both horse & rider in the same entry qualifies as a new entry & must be paid in full.
26. If you would like to edit your horse or rider details before the closing date of the event please login to your Horse Events account & edit your booking under the ‘MY BOOKING’ Tab
27. If you would like to change the class please email info@horse-events.co.uk & if there is space available they will do this for you.

Saracen Connemara Eventing Championships Qualifier 10th/11th September 2022

In order to compete at the championships, the owner of the pony needs to be an Adult/Junior Member of the British Connemara Pony Society. Ponies must be pure, part-bred or overheight Connemaras, which are registered or overstamped on the BCPS database. The pony must be in the correct ownership.
