# **Classes 2- 6 are qualifiers for the Cricklands National Championships of Great Britain.**

## **Schedule**

Class 1: 45 cm Lead Rein or Assisted. 10 yrs and under.

Class 2: 50 cm (may be assisted but NOT lead).  
Cricklands Qualifier.

Class 3: 60 cm. No assistance allowed. Cricklands Qualifier.

Class 4: 70 cm. No assistance allowed. Cricklands Qualifier.

Class 5: 80 cm. No assistance allowed. Cricklands Qualifier.

Class 6: 90 cm. No assistance allowed. Cricklands Qualifier.

Entry Fees: £12 per person per class plus £2 First Aid for entries before midnight on 14<sup>th</sup> April. Late entry fee of £15 plus £2 First Aid charged from 15<sup>th</sup> until 17<sup>th</sup> April when entries will close.

PLEASE NOTE: £2 payable for First Aid is per rider not per class.

Classes 2 to 6 inclusive are Cricklands National Championships of Great Britain Qualifiers. Jump entire course clear and you will qualify for the Championships at Cricklands, South Wales in August 2018

Teams of 3 or 4 members, best 3 scores count.

Rosettes from 1<sup>st</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> in each class for individuals and 1st to 6th for teams.

Single Phase competition – second half of course is timed.

# Rules

1. Ages as at 1st January 2018.
2. Start times will be issued for each rider in each class. These may alter on day depending on how fast classes run. Please be prepared to start earlier or later than set time.
3. This competition will be run under Pony Club Show Jumping Rules 2018. The judge's decision will be final.
4. Classes will be SINGLE PHASE jumping, the second half will be timed. All competitors may jump the second half unless they have been eliminated.
5. No rider may ride more than one horse/pony in any one team. No horse/pony can be ridden in more than two classes.
6. Teams must present themselves for tack inspection a minimum of 15 minutes before they jump. It is the responsibility of the Team Manager to familiarise the competitors with the correct turnout requirements.
7. Correct protective helmets must be worn comply with the 2018 Pony Club rules which can be found at [www.pcuk.org/index.php/dcs\\_health\\_safety/dress\\_and\\_tack/](http://www.pcuk.org/index.php/dcs_health_safety/dress_and_tack/). Failure to comply will result in elimination.
8. The wearing of body protectors is recommended.
9. The warm up arena will be stewarded and will run with one team competing and two teams warming up.
10. The jumps in the warm up arena must not exceed the height of the jumps in the main ring.
11. The organisers reserve the right to alter/cancel classes at their discretion. Also change start times. Please be prepared and allow enough time for classes to run early or late.
12. Late changes/additions to entries will be accepted at the organiser's discretion.
13. Liability: Neither the landowners, organisers, nor any person acting on their behalf accept any liability for any loss, damage, accident, injury or illness to horses, riders, spectators or any other persons or property whatsoever.
14. The organiser of the Event has taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organiser and all the Officials and Stewards.
15. Dogs must preferably be left at home. Those that have to be brought to the event must be kept on leads at all times.
